a brain is an organ that serves as the center of the nervous system in all vertebrate and most invertebrate animals it is located in the head usually close to the sensory organs for senses such as vision it is the most complex organ in a vertebrate s body the brain is one of the largest and most complex organs in the human body it is made up of more than 100 billion nerves that communicate in trillions of connections called synapses the brain is jan 5 2023 brain the mass of nerve tissue in the anterior end of an organism the brain integrates sensory information and directs motor responses in higher vertebrates it is
